### **2. Update on ESO interface with AMR's ePCR platform**

Paul Priest said AMR is all dialed in from their side.  
Had meeting with ESO, Chief Llewellyn attended with us.  
Waiting for movement on ESO side, then move into testing.  
On phone with them 2 weeks ago, haven't heard back from them since.  
Health Data Exchange (HDE)  
No feedback from hospitals, yet.  
Providence signed; 4-5 months down the road for HDE.  
Multicare in Tacoma is already on it.  
Waiting for some testing.

ESO, good educational piece for Paramedics.  
ESO pushes a button to share/transmit, we can grab it and add it into PCR.  
Unique Patient Identifier field that will match with the hospital.

Paul Priest said AMR is ready and waiting, but they are tying up some loose ends. Probably building it on the ESO side to lay the ground work to add other agencies. Agreements between AMR and user agencies for exchange of data. AMR under contract already, think they are covered there. WiFi modem, adding in new ones that allow other agencies to be added/ hooked up. Working to update 24-25 vehicles right now. Costly, 2 year time frame allowable, will try to beat that
