This letter is being sent to provide information related to the requirement for the annual inspection of medical gas systems as required by the International Fire Code (IFC) as amended by Washington State.

The systems shall be inspected per the requirements of the edition/year of NFPA 99 and IFC that the system was installed under. The inspections shall be conducted by a qualified third party (the fire department does not perform these inspections). The purpose of the inspection is to ensure that system components continue to function as originally designed and approved; and that critical components are maintained properly.
