Residential Yard and Garden Waste*

NOT ALLOWED

Campfire and Recreational Fires

Campfires

Recreational Fires/In ground Pits

- * Firewood or charcoal
- * No wider than 3'
- * No higher than 2'
- * 25' from structures (IFC 307.4.2)
- * Attended
- * Extinguishing tools
- * Completely extinguish when done
- * Not a nuisance to neighbors

Allowed

Unless outdoor burn ban or air quality issues

Portable Manufactured Outdoor Burning Devices

- * Fireplaces
- * Barbecues
- * Patio warmers

Must use approved fuels*

In accordance with manufactures instructions

Allowed

Unless air quality issues

Trash

NOT ALLOWED

* Residential Yard & Garden Waste: Comprised of leaves, needles, tree and shrub prunings, and other natural yard and garden waste from improved property.
 * Approved Fuels: Charcoal, clean and dry wood, propane/natural gas.
 * Non Approved Fuels: Lumber, mill ends, trash, paper, cardboard, etc.
